INTEGRAL U METHODOLOGY

Integral means inclusive, integrous, comprehensive, and holistic! Integral theory is a framework for engaging the most learned academics, sages, and wisdom holders whose offerings of enlightened intellectual, philosophical and spiritual history have been woven into a tapestry of disciplines which empower and enable us to navigate our world of human experience through a common language. By doing this it includes the richness of diverse cultures and approaches towards a unity principle of us as a humankind by acknowledging our differences or parts, and enabling us to see the greater whole.

How does this help us?

- It enables us to take a journey through the key components of a deep understanding of human experience and our cultivation of consciousness from ego to wisdom leadership and practice
- Like any mastery practice, it is a journey of working from the simple to the complex and back to simplicity again – but from a more expansive range of visioning and sense making to see, feel, sense, and think further, wider, deeper and higher
- Through learning this common language we can more easily find each other across the board room tables, in our communities, and simply through relationship

- By cultivating and growing and liberating our individual and collective intelligence through vision logic we learn to see more, grow the capacity to manage ourselves more, to actively work with complexity so as to regenerate economies, communities, societies, and our humane and spiritual connection to each other in the work we do and purpose for which we live
- Both the individual and collective wisdoms are engaged through the ongoing dance with each other in our subjective experiences to open our thinking to larger possibilities. This then becomes our being and doing as we take this insight and intelligence into the world of tangible results
- Importantly, it is up to each of you to find your own story within the framework and to work through your own personal and professional or organizational territories
